Planning Board

Elizabeth Callahan reported that the board had a presentation by the new school superintendent. This included the future of the school and registering for the K-Solar program.

Jody Perry has been issued a special use permit to replace a manufactured home destroyed by fire.

Board officers remain the same. They are reviewing the by-laws.

A notice of decision approving a lot split for the Hare property has been received by the Board.

Zoning Law

In the process of reviewing a permit for a manufactured home, it was discovered that there are some town roads that are in the R2 zone on the zoning map even though the wording of the law states that R2 is along county roads. The planning board will review the wording of the zoning law and the map and will recommend wording to make the zone boundaries and map in agreement. It is the advice of the town attorney to keep the map as is.

Code Officer

Dan Wilber has issued a couple of permits.

There was discussion of a tractor on town road right of way. Mr. Wilber will issue an order to remedy to have the tractor will be removed, or the town may look into further legal action.

Highway Report

Mr. Hurlburt has received complaints about the condition of some of the county roads. Residents need to contact Otsego Co. and Mr. Hurlburt will also make the county aware.

Use of Building

Dennis Higgins asked to reserve the municipal building for a presentation by SouthernTierSolarWorks, a nonprofit solar organization. The board gave permission and they can contact the town clerk to set a date.

Gas Drilling

Martha Bremer thanked the board for putting the gas hydrofracking moratorium in place and feels that local governments were influential in having hydrofracking stopped in New York State.

Mark Dye responded that our moratorium had expired before the state decision was made.

Association of Towns

The town clerk had information for the board about the annual meeting of the association that is held in February.

Mr. Anderson reported on an announcement forwarded to the town clerk from the DEC; he also spoke about Stop the Pipeline filing for a re-hearing on the Constitution pipeline project certificate because of "project segmentation".
