## Section 1. PURPOSE

This local law is enacted pursuant to Section 512(1-a) of the New York State Real Property Tax Law, to establish an Alternate Date for the meeting of the Town of Otego Board of Assessment Review, known as "Grievance Day." This local law is necessary because the Town of Otego employs an assessor who also serves as an assessor in another municipality and is not available to attend Grievance Day in the Town of Otego on the fourth Tuesday of May.

## Section 2. ALTERNATE DATE FOR GRIEVANCE DAY

Commencing in calendar year 2013, the Town of Otego Board of Assessment Review shall meet for Grievance Day on an Alternate Date, which shall be the fourth Wednesday of May, and so many days thereafter as the Town of Otego Board of Assessment Review deems necessary.

## Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
