BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Otego as follows:

Section 1.

The purpose of this article is to set the number of members of the Town Board of Assessment Review. This article is authorized by § 523 of the Real Property Tax Law and § 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 2.

The number of members of the Town Board of Assessment Review shall be decreased from five to three.

Section 3.

All Ordinances, Local Laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 4.

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5.

This Local Law shall become effective: 1) on November 1, 2021; and 2) upon its filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
