County Representative

Mr. Brockway reported that he has helped obtain two \$50,000 grants for the Town of Otego and the Village of Otego. The committee will meet the first Wednesday of November but he will get together with Allen Ruffles next week to expedite the process.

Highway Report

Mr. Hurlburt reported that all of the CHIPS paperwork has been mailed out and the trucks are all serviced and ready for winter. In addition, he has a new applicant, Josh Shumway, who will be taking the CDL course at Milford BOCES. Royce Livingston made a motion, seconded by Jimmy Hamm to approve the hiring of Mr. Shumway contingent upon Beth Westfall preparing an agreement on CDL training expenses. 5 Ayes, 0 Nays.

Planning Board

The planning board is working on 2 subdivisions and have also received inquiries from a developer as to a 12 lot subdivision on upper Green Street but have not received any paperwork yet.

The Zoning commission continues to make good progress on the new zoning document.

Budget

The board has finalized the 2023 Town of Otego tentative budget. A motion was made by Royce Livingston, seconded by Barbara Stanton to hold a public hearing for Wednesday, October 26th at 6:00 pm, after which the Town Board will take action.

Jim Hurlburt

Jim Hurlburt, along with other members of the highway department, asked the board to consider a bonus for their efforts in working with one less driver for almost all of 2022. The board will discuss it after the public hearing on Wednesday, October 26, 2022.

Barb Stanton

At the_village youth recreation meeting it was noted that the Otego Town Pool needed refurbishing. She presented the board with an estimate of the supplies required. Barbara Stanton made a motion, seconded by Royce Livingston to issue a check to the Village Youth Recreation Committee for \$2046.00 for paint and filters.

Local Law # 3 of 2022

Local Law # 3, entitled "A Local Law Amending the Town of Otego Zoning Ordinance" to amend the zoning classification of several tax map parcels from R1 (Residential Commercial District) to R4 (Light Industrial Overlay District) was sent to the County and they sent back their approval. A motion was made by Terry Brown, seconded by Royce Livingston to approve Local Law # 3 of 2022.

JCAP Grant

In the interest of fulfilling one of the Courts requests, Supervisor Hurlburt has obtained an estimate of \$14,200.00 for moving the air conditioner thermostat as well as fixing the remaining air conditioning issues. Beth Westfall suggested we need two quotes due to the dollar amount under our procurement policy.
