Mr. Hurlburt reported that the new pickup has been received; roads are being sealed; removed dead tree on the Roland Hill Museum property in village.

### Planning Board

### Phone/FAX/Internet Provider

The board was in receipt of the quote for construction of a line to the highway dept. for internet service and the cost of phone lines for the highway dept. and municipal building.

## **Town of Otego/September 12,2018**

A motion was made by Royce Livingston, seconded by David Sheldon, to switch to Spectrum as the sole provider and accept the quote from Spectrum for construction. Motion: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays.

### **Health Insurance**

Barbara Stanton met with Kevin Morse concerning the health insurance. The quote for the renewal has gone up, but still less than previous increases. It was suggested that there be a board member to be a liaison to the health insurance to receive pertinent information.

### **Board of Assessment Review**

A motion was made by Barbara Stanton, seconded by David Sheldon, to appoint Rosemary Holbrook to the Board of Assessment Review for a 5 year term. Motion: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays.

### **Justice Court Grant**

The following resolution was put forward by David Sheldon, seconded by Terry Brown:

WHEREAS, the Otego Justice Court is a local court processing approximately 1700 traffic cases, 130 criminal cases, and 35 civil cases per year, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the court facility in good working order and to maintain security,

THEREFORE, the Otego Town board authorizes the town supervisor to sign the Justice Court Assistance Grant application to obtain state funding to improve the operation and safety of the local justice court.

Motion; 5 Ayes, 0 Nays.

### **Standard Work Day Resolution**

The town clerk had a corrected workday resolution. After discussion, the town attorney wants to speak to the Retirement System, as she wants to make certain that appointed officials need to update their work hours if they are not new appointments.

### **Historian Report**

Mary Johnson-Butler gave the board her annual report.

### **Stuart Anderson**

Mr. Anderson addressed the board about electricity that is generated and sold by localities, such as Jamestown, Sherburne and Blenheim-Gilboa. He wanted to know if the town might consider building a small water powered closed loop electrical system. There is grant money available. Discussion followed. Glenn Seroka brought up a wind power project in the town of Guilford. The board was not sure of the feasibility of such a water powered system in the town that would be able to tie in to the Otego electrical substation. No action will be taken at this time.

### **School Proposal Status**

At the August 27 meeting of the Unatego school board it was voted to give the town 11.03 acres along Willow Street. A copy of the map showing the subdivision was reviewed by the board. Beth Westfall, town attorney, will contact the school attorney.
